

 Visit Plymouth Plantation Living History Museums — It is the site of a living museum dedicated to recreating 17th century life ways in the New World with the Wampanoag's. Step back in time as costumed interpreters portray residents of the colony.



- Admission to the Mayflower II Aboard the Mayflower II you can share in the experience of when the Pilgrims crossed from England to America in 1620.
- Guided Tour of Plymouth with Photo Stop at Plymouth Rock – Home of our Pilgrim Fathers and one of the country's first settlements, it is well known in the United States for its historical value. A picture stop will be made at the Forefather's Monument,

the largest, solid granite monument in the United States. She stands facing the harbor, welcoming those who come by water. A picture stop will also be made at Plymouth Rock, the traditional site of disembarkation of the Pilgrims in 1620.

○ Enjoy a Lobstering Tour Cruise "Lobster Tales" - This Lobstering Eco Tour will immerse you in the vibrant culture of New England! You'll dive headfirst into the world of lobster harvesting. In the calm waters of Plymouth Bay, passengers will have a front-row seat to witness the mesmerizing marine life of Plymouth Harbor. Prepare yourself to see (and hold) all kinds of animals, from lively crabs and curious snails to the occasional fishy friend.





- Guided Tour of Provincetown, MA Sand dunes and the ocean surround you as you approach "Land's End". Thirty miles of beach front, magnificent dunes and a stunning harbor are just a few reasons to travel to the outermost part of the Cape. Provincetown is also an artist's haven, a historic and active seaport, and a shopping and dining paradise.
- Drive along the Cape Cod National
 Seashore Forty miles of pristine sandy beach,

marshes, ponds, and uplands support diverse species. Lighthouses, cultural landscapes, and wild cranberry bogs offer a glimpse of Cape Cod's past and continuing ways of life. Visit the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor Center.
